

## Family Domestic Abuse Caseworker/Facilitator

## Responsibilities:

- Deliver a professional support service for a diverse group of men and women, in line with the charity's mission statement and its values
- To adhere and contribute to the charity's professional reputation within the community
- Take responsibility for your own personal development and contribute towards the development of services within the charity in response to need

## **Duties include:**

- Support delivery of outcomes agreed with the charity
- Process referrals for people who are or have experienced domestic abuse, from a variety of agencies and self-referrals
- Assess and formulate a recovery programme for clients (including risk assessment/management), signposting to other services where appropriate
- Assess client progress at regular intervals utilising charities outcome measures
- Deliver a range of in-house therapeutic programmes
- Support other staff members in ad hoc groups where requested (e.g. art therapy)
- Hold an active caseload of clients and target direct work
- Liaise with Children's Therapists
- Record and update data surrounding client profile, attendance, client feedback and outcomes
- Attend external meetings on zoom where requested
- Attend personal development sessions and training
- Ensure protocols are observed in line with our policies and procedures
- Attend weekly staff meetings
